 - (c) Add Cross-Connection Control, Irrigation Systems, and Backflow Prevention section.
6. Discuss and act on installing a partition wall inside the Allen Pump Station to create a designated area for an air conditioner, ensuring protection of electrical equipment and limiting air conditioner use to that portion of the room.

 - (d) Lotus Creek – A residential subdivision located on the northwest side of CR 221 and southwest of Neal Road in Forney, Texas
